Why this is important

More people are using NHS services, but money is limited.

The CCG's £1.3 billion pays for things such as doctors, hospitals, community services, some pharmacy services and mental health services.

But the CCG is operating with £75m debt. It needs to make some tough decisions about saving money this year and spending less money in the future.

The Community Values Panel will help them understand what is important to local people.

What will happen

- Your role will be explained to you at the first meeting.
- You will be asked to work in small groups to discuss various topics and give your thoughts and opinions.
- These will be written up into a report and given back to the CCG.
- We will provide a light lunch on the day.
